



Pitts' Mitts

Craft: Knitting

Difficulty: Beginner

Materials:

Yarn – Malabrigo Merino Worsted (100% merino wool; 210 yd [192m]/3.5 oz [100 gm]);
CYCA1/medium: 1 ball “Jewel Blue,”
1 ball “Lettuce,” 1 ball “Polar Morn,”
and 1 ball “Tureg.”

Needles – Size 6 (4mm) double pointed needles and size 7 (4.5mm) double pointed needles. Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain correct gauge.

Notions – A stitch holder, 3 stitch markers, and a tapestry needle.

Gauge: 23 st = 4” wide in Stockinette st on larger needles, post-blocking. Take time to check gauge.

Available Sizes: women’s medium

Measurements: Approximately 9” high and 7” in circumference, post-blocking.

**Abbreviations:**

CO = Cast On
DPN = Double Pointed Needle
K = Knit
K2tog = Knit Two Together
MC = Main Color
M1R = Make One Right
M1L = Make One Left
PM = Place Marker
SL = Slip
SSK = Slip, Slip, Knit
Sts= Stitches

Instructions:***Right Mitten*****Cuff:**

With smaller needles, cast on 36 sts,
join for working in the round

Work in 1x1 ribbing (*K1, P1, repeat
from * to end of round) until cuff
measures 2” from beginning. Switch
to larger needles

Next round: *K4, M1, repeat from * to
end of round - 45 sts

Work 4 rounds even

Thumb Gusset:

Gusset round 1 (set up round): K4, PM, M1R, PM, K to end of round

Round 2 and all even gusset rounds: K all sts slipping markers as you come to them

Round 3: K4, SL M, M1R, K1, M1L, SL M, K to end of round - 3 sts between markers

Round 5: K4, SL M, M1R, K3, M1L, SL M, K to end of round - 5 sts

Round 7: K4, SL M, M1R, K5, M1L, SL M, K to end of round - 7 sts

K4, SL M, M1R, K7, M1L, SL M, K to end of round - 9 sts

Next round: K all sts removing markers on each side of thumb gusset as you come to them

Next round: K3, Sl 1, place 9 thumb sts onto stitch holder, place slipped back onto left-hand needle, K2tog over gap, K to end of round

Work 2 round even

Work through rows 1-15 of fair-isle chart. Work even in MC until mitten measures 9" from beginning

Decreasing:

Decrease round 1: K1, SSK, K16, K2tog, K1, PM, K1, SSK, K16, K2tog, K1

Decrease round 2: work even

Decrease round 3: K1, SSK, K to 3 sts before next marker, K1, K2tog, slip marker, K1, SSK, K to 3 sts before end of round, K2tog, K1

Repeat last 2 rows until 11 sts remain

Cut tail and using a tapestry needle, weave through remaining sts twice and pull top of mitten closed.

Thumb:

With one DPN slip 5 sts from holder on to needle, with a second DPN slip the remaining 4 sts from holder on to needle, and with a third DPN attach yarn and pick up 8 sts along edge over the other two needles -17 sts

Thumb round 1: K 9, K2tog 4 times across the 8 picked up stitches - 13 sts

Work in round until thumb measures 2.25"

*K2tog, repeat from * to last st, K1

Cut tail and using tapestry needle, weave through remaining sts and pull top of thumb closed. Weave in remaining tails.

Left Mitten

Work as for right mitten until the thumb gusset

Thumb Gusset:

Gusset round 1 (set up round): K18, PM, M1R, PM, K to end of round

Round 2 and all even gusset rounds: K all sts slipping markers as you come to them

Round 3: K18, SL M, M1R, K1, M1L, SL M, K to end of round (3 sts between markers)

Round 5: K18, SL M, M1R, K3, M1L, SL M, K to end of round (5 sts)

Round 7: K18, SL M, M1R, K5, M1L, SL M, K to end of round (7 sts)

K18, SL M, M1R, K7, M1L, SL M, K to end of round (9 sts)

Next round: K all sts removing markers as you come to them

Next round: K17, Sl 1, place 9 thumb sts onto stitch holder, remove second maker, place slipped back onto left-hand needled, K2tog over gap, K to end of round

Work 2 rounds even

Work through rows 1-15 of fair isle chart, then work even in MC until mitten measures 9" from beginning

Work decreasing and thumb as for right mitten.
