MATERIALS

Yarn: Rowan Kidsilk Haze (75% Super Kid Mohair, 30% silk; 229yd [210m]/1oz [25g]; CYCA 1): 00582, Trance (MC), 1 skein, 00642, Ghost (CC), 1 skein.

Needles: US size 10(6mm) needles; US size J/10 (6mm) crochet hook (optional, for use in attaching tassels). Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain correct gauge.

Notions: Tapestry needle

AVAILABLE SIZES

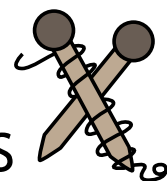
One size.

MEASUREMENTS

About 6" wide and 54" long plus 2 x 6" tassels.

POPPINS

Inspired by one of the classic English movie characters, Miss Mary Poppins, this scarf uses a simple but unusual 4-row repeat to generate a light openwork fabric, perfect for chilly days or as a delicate accessory to a stylish outfit. Using double yarn overs and twisted stitches this pattern provides a great introduction to more advanced knitting skills for those eager to try something new. This stitch pattern is very closely inspired by the original Mary Poppins scarf, and together this pattern provides a subtle homage to cinema's greatest nanny.



GAUGE

19 stitches and 17 rows = 4" in Poppins Pattern.

Cast on 24 stitches and work in pattern for 18 rows. Measure swatch to check gauge. Gauge remains the same after blocking.

STITCH GUIDE

Double Yarn Over (y2o): Wrap yarn around needle twice.

Twist stitches (tw2): Insert right needle into 2nd stitch on left hand needle as if to purl, purl but do not drop the stitch. Purl the first stitch on the left hand needle. Drop both stitches off needle together.

Poppins Stitch pattern:

Row 1: K2, *ssk, y2o, k2tog; rep from * across, end k2.

Row 2: P1, tw2, *p1, p1tbl, tw2; rep from * across, end p1.

Row 3: K2, yo, k2tog, *ssk, y2o, k2tog; rep from * across, end ssk, yo, k2.

Row 4: P3, tw2, *p1, p1tbl, tw2; rep from * across, end p3.

Repeat Rows 1-4 for pattern repeat.

INSTRUCTIONS

SCARF

With MC, CO 28 sts.

*With MC, work Rows 1-4 of Poppins Stitch pattern six times.

Work rows 1-2 once more.

Change to CC. Work rows 3-4 of Poppins Stitch pattern and then work rows 1-4 six times.

Repeat from * until 5 MC and 4 CC stripes have been completed. Bind off.

FINISHING

Block scarf so that each stripe measures 6" square.

Weave in ends.



TASSELS

Cut twenty-four 14" lengths of each color. Take 2 of each color and twist together loosely. With right side facing insert a crochet hook from the back through one of the large eyelets generated by the y2o stitch. Gently pull the center of the strands through to the back so that a loop is formed. Pass the ends of the tassel strands through this loop and pull to secure. Repeat this 6 times on both ends of the scarf. Carefully trim the tassels to 6" length.
